Goodyear Library to re-open in new location on Jan. 29

The Goodyear Branch of the Maricopa Library District will soon start a new chapter with expanded services in a different location. The library's last day in its current location is Saturday, Jan. 18-at 5 p.m.

The library will temporarily be closed but will-re-open in its new location at 10 a.m. on Wednesday, Jan. 29 in the Goodyear Municipal Complex, 14455 W. Van Buren Street, Suite C-101. Library customers can return materials to the outside Drop Box at the new location beginning Wednesday, Jan. 22.

Hours of operation will stay the same: 10 a.m. to 7 p.m. Monday through Wednesday, and 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. Thursday through Saturday.

A grand opening and ribbon cutting ceremony of the new library - a 9,000-square-foot facility with a multi-purpose room and an incubator space for entrepreneurs and start-up businesses - will be held from 9 a.m. to 11 a.m. on Friday, Feb. 28.

"We're excited about moving into a new location with more space," said Erin Macfarlane, Branch Manager for the Goodyear Branch of the Maricopa County Library District. "More people come into the library every day to do things like check out books and DVDs, research information on the computer, and attend library programs and events. As interest in the library grows, we need more space to accommodate our community. The library will provide that."

The Goodyear Branch Library is a partnership of the city of Goodyear and the Maricopa County Library District. Library cards are available free to Maricopa County residents with a photo ID and proof that you live in the county. Children under 18 must have a guardian present.
