Notifying the Public of Rights under Title VI

CITY OF GOODYEAR

The city of Goodyear operates its programs and services without regard to race, color, national origin or disability in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964. Any person who believes she or he has been aggrieved by any unlawful discriminatory practice under Title VI may file a complaint with the city of Goodyear.
