- **What:** Construction associated with installation of remediation pipeline for groundwater extraction well EC-03.
- **Where:** City of Goodyear right-of-way on S. 143rd Avenue (starting at extraction well EC-03) and north to W. Van Buren St. The remediation pipeline will continue along the south side of W. Van Buren St. to approximately 1,100 feet west of N. Litchfield Rd., before heading south to the former Unidynamics facility.
- **When:** Pipeline construction activities are expected to last four weeks starting on February 28, 2018. Construction hours on S. 143rd Avenue are planned for 7:30 a.m. to 4 p.m.; and on W. Van Buren St. from 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
- **How You May Be Affected:** Businesses and residents should expect some noise during the construction activities and are asked to abide by the traffic signs and barricades in the area. Two-way traffic on 143rd Avenue will remain open; however, the southbound bike lane will be closed. On W. Van Buren St., the south eastbound line will be closed.

History: Crane Co., the owner of the former Unidynamics facility on Litchfield Road, with oversight from EPA and the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality, is ordering the testing of the groundwater to determine the impact of chemical disposal practices decades ago at the former defense industry facility.
