August-September 2018

- **What:** Drilling and installation of remediation well and pipeline for groundwater injection well IA-17.
- **Where:** City of Goodyear right-of-way on N. Las Verdes Dr. (starting at injection well IA-17) and south to E. La Pasada Dr. The remediation pipeline will continue west along E. La Pasada Dr. to N. Los Olivos Dr., then south along N. Los Olivos Dr. to connect to the existing pipeline approximately 160 feet north of Loma Linda Blvd.
- **When:** Construction activities are expected to last a total of approximately six to eight non-continuous weeks starting on August 7, 2018. Construction hours are generally planned between 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. on weekdays. Barricades may remain up on various weekends as necessary.
- **How You May Be Affected:** Businesses and residents should expect some noise during the construction activities and are asked to abide by the traffic signs and barricades in the area. Efforts will be made to cause the least disruption to businesses and residents.

History: Crane Co., the owner of the former Unidynamics facility on Litchfield Road, with oversight from EPA and the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality, is ordering the testing of the groundwater to determine the impact of chemical disposal practices decades ago at the former defense industry facility.
