



City of Goodyear Community Advisory

November 2018 – January 2019

- **What:** Drilling and installation of three remediation wells (groundwater extraction well EA-12, groundwater injection wells IA-19 and IA-20), two piezometers (PZ-20 and PZ-21), and pipelines between the remediation wells and treatment systems.
- **Where:** City of Goodyear flood basins north of Interstate 10 (I-10) on both sides of Litchfield Road and Union Pacific RR property. Pipelines will cross Litchfield Road north of I-10.
- **When:** Construction activities are expected to last a total of approximately six to eight non-continuous weeks starting on November 26, 2018. Construction hours are generally planned between 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. on weekdays. Barricades may remain up on various weekends as necessary.
- **How You May Be Affected:** Businesses and residents should expect some noise during the construction activities and are asked to abide by the traffic signs and barricades in the area. Efforts will be made to cause the least disruption to businesses and residents.

History: Crane Co., the owner of the former Unidynamics facility on Litchfield Road, with oversight from EPA and the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality, is ordering the testing of the groundwater to determine the impact of chemical disposal practices decades ago at the former defense industry facility.
