



# City of Goodyear Community Advisory

October-November 2019

- **What:** Installation of underground pipeline for one groundwater injection well (IA-19).
- **Where:** City of Goodyear right-of-way (ROW) along eastern shoulder of N. 145<sup>th</sup> Avenue (starting at injection well IA-19) south to W. McDowell Rd. The remediation pipeline will continue east along McDowell Rd. and connect to existing pipeline which ends at McDowell Rd. and the former Union Pacific Railroad property between McLane Sunwest and the drainage ditch west of the Ulta Beauty store. Pipeline installation activities will begin on McDowell Rd. adjacent to the tie-in location to the existing pipeline.
- **When:** Construction activities are expected to last a total of approximately six continuous weeks starting on October 14, 2019. Construction hours are generally planned between 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. on weekdays.
- **How You May Be Affected:** Businesses and residents should expect some noise during the construction activities and are asked to abide by the traffic signs and barricades in the area. Efforts will be made to cause the least disruption to businesses and residents.

**History:** Crane Co., the owner of the former Unidynamics facility on Litchfield Road, with oversight from EPA and the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality, is ordering the testing of the groundwater to determine the impact of chemical disposal practices decades ago at the former defense industry facility.
