



City of Goodyear Community Advisory

January-February 2020

- **What:** Drilling, installation, and development of one groundwater extraction well (EA-13).
- **Where:** Western shoulder of N. Litchfield Rd. between W. McDowell Rd. and Palm Valley Blvd., in City of Goodyear right-of-way.
- **When:** Well drilling and installation activities are expected to last a total of approximately two to three weeks starting on January 20, 2020. Construction hours are generally planned between 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Barricades may remain up on a 24-hour basis during the project. Another Community Advisory will be sent for additional activities such as pipeline and well vault installation.
- **How You May Be Affected:** Businesses and residents should expect some noise during the construction activities and are asked to abide by the traffic signs and barricades in the area. Efforts will be made to cause the least disruption to businesses and residents.

History: Crane Co., the owner of the former Unidynamics facility on Litchfield Road, with oversight from EPA and the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality, is ordering the testing of the groundwater to determine the impact of chemical disposal practices decades ago at the former defense industry facility.
